# CHINO SKATE PARK

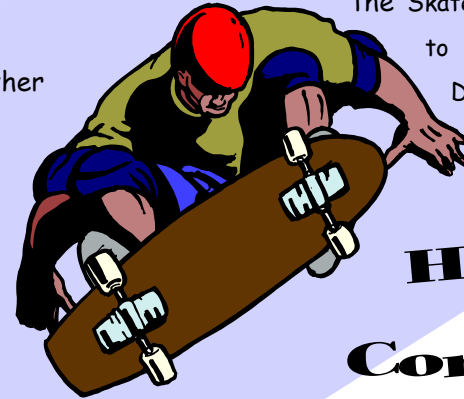
## Here are the Rules...

- 1.** No skating or skateboarding after hours. Hours of operation will be posted and are subject to change without prior notice.
- 2.** The Skate Park is to be used for skating and skateboarding only.
- 3.** Anyone using the skate park **MUST** wear a **shirt** and proper safety equipment including, a **helmet**, **elbow pads**, and **kneepads**. This equipment must be functional, protective, properly sized and designed for skating or skateboarding purposes.
- 4.** Only roller skates, in-line skates or skateboards are allowed in the Skate Park. (That means, **NO bikes**, **NO scooters**, **NO wagons**, or any other **wheeled devices**.)
- 5.** No alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products are allowed in the Skate Park.
- 6.** Do not litter.
- 7.** Do not tag, graffiti, or attach stickers in or on the Skate Park or surrounding area.

- 8.** Ride safely. Riding recklessly is prohibited.
- 9.** Glass containers and other glass products are prohibited.
- 10.** No ramps, jumps, or other obstacles may be placed in the Skate Park.
- 11.** Do not use the Skate Park if a hazardous condition exists (i.e., inclement weather, significant cracks, breaks, or other irregularities to the skating surface).
- 12.** Personal stereos, earphones, and headphones are prohibited.
- 14.** All organized events at the Skate Park must have written approval of the Department of Community Services.
- 13.** No animals are allowed in the Skate Park.
- 15.** The City of Chino is not responsible for items that are lost or stolen at the Skate Park.



- 16.** Any person suffering an injury within the Skate Park must promptly report the injury to the City of Chino's Risk Management Department at (909) 591-9807.

## Here are the Consequences...

- **Temporary Closure of the Park**  
If a majority of skaters are not in compliance with the skate park rules the park will be temporarily closed.
- **Ejection from the Skate Park**  
Any person violating park rules may be told to leave the Skate Park for a period of 48 hours by any City Employee.
- **Citation**  
Any person violating the rules listed above, may be cited.
- **Arrest**  
Any person failing to leave the Skate Park when told to do so or, returning within 48 hours, may be subject to arrest.
