



The Armed Forces Banner Program was initiated by the City of Chino to honor and recognize Chino's active duty military personnel.

To qualify, honorees must meet the following requirements:

- Active duty member of the United States Armed Forces; and
- Is a current Chino resident; or
- Is an immediate family member of a Chino resident.  
*(Parent, wife/husband, sibling, son/daughter, grandson/granddaughter, son-in-law/daughter-in-law, aunt/uncle, and niece/nephew).*

As an ongoing program, applications will be accepted at any time. Banners will be installed four times per year: January, May, September, and November. Timing of the banner installation and removal will be at the City's discretion. Banners may be displayed for a minimum of one (1) year, or throughout their tour of duty (depending on space) before being retired and given to honoree or honoree's family.

A follow-up email will notify the applicant of the week of installation for the requested banner.
