## Recipients

The P.A.T.C.H program is available to anyone who meets the following criteria:

- **Chino resident**
- **50 years and older**
- **Meet CDBG income guidelines**

The Case Manager will screen potential participants for eligibility. Eligible participants will need to provide supporting documentation, such as ID, medicine prescription, pharmacy receipt, etc. The disbursement may be all or a portion of the prescription costs. Payments will be made directly to the pharmacy as long as funds are available.
