City of Chino Accepting Applications for Community Services Commission

CHINO, CA – The City of Chino is currently accepting applications from interested residents for the Community Services Commission to fill three (3) positions for a three-year term ending on June 30, 2026, and one (1) position to fill an unscheduled vacancy for a term ending June 30, 2024.

The Community Services Commission is a seven-member board that acts in an advisory capacity to the City Council and the Community Services Department on issues that will contribute to improving the quality of life in Chino. These issues are focused in the areas of Recreation, Human Services, Parks, and Open Space.

Six members of the Commission are appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Chino City Council. The seventh member-at-large is selected by the other six members of the Commission and ratified by the City Council. Terms are for three years, on a rotating basis.

Applicants must be residents of the City of Chino and submit a completed application form by Friday, May 12, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. to the City Clerk's office at 13220 Central Avenue Chino, CA 91710 or by email at cityclerk@cityofchino.org. The application is available at www.cityofchino.org/cscommission.

Upon review of the applications, the Mayor, along with the City Council member that is the liaison to the Community Services Commission, will select and interview potential candidates. Pursuant to Chino Municipal Code, Commissioners are appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council. The application review period is estimated to take approximately four (4) weeks. It is anticipated that selections will be made by June 20, 2023, with the City Council's consideration of the appointments scheduled for June 20.

Community Services Commission meetings are held on the fourth Monday of every month at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of Chino City Hall, 13220 Central Avenue, Chino, CA 91710. Additional occasional workshops and tours are held as required.
